The matter was sent before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, where both the parties have amicably settled their matrimonial dispute. The settlement agreement entered into between them is placed on record.

In terms of the settlement respondent husband is to pay a sum of Rs.5 lacs towards permanent alimony for the appellant wife. A sum of Rs.2.5 lacs in the shape of a demand draft was handed over by the counsel for the respondent to the counsel for the appellant. The remaining sum of Rs.2.5 lacs is to be paid by the respondent at the time when the criminal proceedings initiated by the appellant against the respondent and his family members are quashed.

In view of the above development and in the background of the settlement arrived at between the parties before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court, counsel for the appellant seeks permission to withdraw the present appeal.

Prayer is allowed.

The present appeal stands dismissed as withdrawn.
