The grievance of the appellant is that name of the earlier company, namely, M/s Galaxy Power Cables Limited was changed to GPC Technology Limited with necessary approval from the competent authority. Certain land was recorded in the ownership of M/s Galaxy Power Cables Limited. With the change of name of the company, the same is required to be mutated in the changed name. The matter was kept pending by Sub Registrar, Dharuhera, District Rewari. The writ petition was dismissed by this court only on the ground that the appellant has effective alternative remedy.

Learned counsel for the respondents fairly submitted that certain documents are required to be submitted by the appellant for consideration of its case for recording change in the name. Once those documents are submitted, the case of the appellant shall be considered in accordance with law. He further submitted that though in para No. 3 of the preliminary objections in the reply filed, the requisite documents have been

mentioned, but still the appellant shall be conveyed all the requisite documents by way of a communication within two weeks.

Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that as and when the appellant receives list of documents to be submitted for changing name, those shall be submitted without any delay. However, a time-bound direction be issued for disposal of the case.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, while setting aside the order passed by the learned Single Judge, the present appeal is disposed of with a direction that the respondents shall communicate to the appellant the documents required for consideration of the claim of the appellant for change of name of the company in the revenue record. The needful be done within a period of two weeks. After the requisite documents are received from the appellant, the matter shall be finally decided by the competent authority within a period of two months thereafter.
