This intra-court appeal under Clause X of the Letters Patent has been filed against the order dated 21.09.2015 passed by the learned Single Judge, whereby the writ petition (CWP No. 23154 of 2012) filed by the appellant challenging the order of the Indian Oil Corporation Limited rejecting his claim for allotment of dealership for setting up Petrol/Diesel Kisan Seva Kendra (Rural Retail Outlet) at village Agampur, Tehsil Anandpur Sahib, District Ropar. The appellant has also challenged the order dated 02.11.2015 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the review application (R.A. No. CW-429 of 2015) filed by him seeking review of the impugned order dated 21.09.2015.

Though there is delay of 58 days in filing the appeal and the

appellant has filed application (CM No. 22-LPA of 2016) for condoning the said delay, yet we have heard learned counsel for the appellant on merits and have gone through the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge.

Undisputedly, the claim of the appellant for allotment of dealership to set up a Petrol/Diesel Kisan Seva Kendra (Rural Retail Outlet) at village Agampur, has been rejected on the ground that high tension power line passes over his land. However, learned counsel for the appellant argued that the said high tension power line is passing over a corner of the land of the appellant and he would get it removed. But the fact remains that the high tension power line still exists over the land of the appellant. In view of this fact, we do not find any ground to interfere with the impugned order passed by the learned Single Judge.

No merit. Dismissed.
