The writ petition filed by the appellants having been dismissed by the learned Single Judge, the order has been impugned by filing the present appeal.

The Subordinate Service Selection Board, Haryana advertised 1,248 posts for Patwar training in Patwar School. The appellants belong to ex-servicemen category. The claim was that 250 posts were reserved in that category and only 32 appointments were made. The candidates, like the appellants being available, they deserved to be offered appointment. The writ petition was dismissed.

It is not in dispute that selections were made in the year 1994. The writ petition was filed in the year 2002. While deciding challenge to the selection, in CWP No. 11526 of 1994—Rajpal Singh and others v. State of Haryana and others, decided on 11.2.2009, though this court opined that there were certain discrepancies in the process of selection, but still keeping

in view the fact that the selected candidates had joined and were working for the last 15 years, did not interfere with the selection of 1,284 candidates, who had already joined but selection beyond 1,284 candidates was set aside. Meaning thereby, all the advertised posts had been filled up.

The aforesaid factors have already been examined by the learned Single Judge in detail, which do not call for any interference by this court in intra-court appeal. Hence, while concurring with the reasons recorded by the learned Single Judge, the present appeal is dismissed.
