SURYA KANT, J.

In deference to the order 1.8.2016, the Review Medical Board of the Research and Referral Hospital, Delhi Cantt. has re-examined the respondent and has opined that he is 'FIT' for recruitment, notwithstanding the surgical scar on his back. In this view of the matter, the apprehension, if any, in the mind of the appellant-authorities stands removed and there is left no cloud on the physical suitability of the respondent. The appeal stands dismissed accordingly. The appellants are directed to take necessary follow-up action and meanwhile allow the respondent to join the training programme before the weekend so that he does not lack in any manner in completion of the training. The appellants shall issue the offer of appointment to the

respondent within two days and shall also complete other requisites for the aforesaid purpose.

It is clarified that the appellants have been directed to allow the respondent to join the training before the weekend keeping in view the fact that such training has started yesterday only, hence the direction issued hereinabove will not be taken as a precedent for future cases.
