This appeal has been directed against the order of the learned Single Judge whereby a challenge to his orders of transfer from Panchkula to Mewat were negated. Learned Single Judge noticed “though the respondents were more than cooperative, I have got the impression that the petitioner did not reciprocate.”

Before this Court also during the course of hearing, the respondents made a very fair offer to the appellant that he can be accommodated at Assandh (District Karnal), Uchana (District Jind), Siwani (District Bhiwani) or Meham (District Rohtak).

Learned counsel for the appellant on instructions from the appellant

who is present in Court has accepted Assandh (District Karnal) to be the place of posting.

In view of the aforesaid consensual stand of the parties, we dispose of the appeal with a direction to the respondents to accommodate appellant in Assandh, District Karnal as per the their offer which has been accepted by the appellant.

Mr. S.S.Dalal, learned counsel for the Bank states that the apprehension of the appellant regarding disciplinary proceedings is totally baseless and they do not intend to do so.
