Main case

Reply on behalf of respondent no.6 has been filed in the Court today and the same is taken on record. A copy thereof has been supplied to the counsel opposite.

We do not find any infirmity in the orders of the learned Single Judge. Naming of an institution to honour a martyr or a local hero would be

purely in the domain of the stake holders and therefore, this Court in the

exercise of its jurisdiction under Article 226 and clause 10 of the Letters Patent Appeal would not find any justification to issue a mandate. However, we make it clear while disposing of the instant appeal that the findings recorded by the learned Single Judge would not come in the way of the stake holders to resolve this issue through mutual settlement.
