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MAHESH GROVER, J.

This appeal is directed against the judgment of learned Single Judge dated 12.10.2015 before whom the challenge was restricted only to the transfer order which was negated since the appellant had set up a plea of transfer being contrary to instructions when he had barely few months to go before his retirement.

Learned Single Judge noticed that the appellant would be entitled to extension in service under the Persons with Disabilities (Equal Opportunities, Protection of Rights and Full

Participation) Act,1995 and the age of retirement thus would go upto 60 years as per instructions dated 19.11.2014 which would ensure the appellant's service till 2018.

We find no infirmity in the observation made by the learned Single Judge negating the challenge to the order of transfer. Before this Court also learned counsel for the appellant has been unable to show any illegality in the order or any exceptional hardship to warrant an interference in a purely administrative order of transfer.

Consequently, we do not find any reason to interfere with the impugned order.

Dismissed.
