Learned counsel for the appellant submitted that he may be permitted to withdraw the writ petition itself with liberty to avail of the remedy under Section 77 of the Registration Act 1908 (for short 'the Act'), however, as the time provided thereafter has expired, he may be given some time to avail of that remedy and the matter may be considered on merits.

After hearing learned counsel for the appellant, we dispose of the present appeal and permit the appellant to withdraw the writ petition itself with liberty to avail the remedy under Section 77 of the Act. In case civil suit is filed on or before 27.5.2016, the same shall be entertained and

considered on merits and shall not be dismissed on the ground of delay only.
