**MAHESH GROVER, J**

There is no representation on behalf of the appellant.

We have perused the impugned judgment and the controversy raised in the writ petition as also in the present appeal. The appellant wants a case to be registered against respondent no.5 for having mis appropriated / embezzled amount by working as a Secretary of Co-operative Society of village Kandhwala Amarkot, Khuian Server, Tehsil Abohar, District Fazilka.

Learned Single Judge disposed of the writ proceedings in the following terms:-

*“1. The petitioner's prayer in the writ petition is to direct the respondent Nos.2 and 3 to register FIR against the 5th respondent under the various provisions of IPC. If the complaint for cognizable offences is made to an officer which is not*

*registered, the petitioner will have a remedy to escalate his own complaint to higher authorities in the manner contemplated under Section 156(3) Cr.P.C. and seek for registration of the complaint.*

*2. The intervention through the writ petition is not necessary. The writ petition is dismissed. ”*

We are, thus, of the opinion that the interest of the appellant had been adequately safeguarded. There is no infirmity or illegality in the impugned judgment which would warrant interference.

Consequently, the appeal is held to be without any merit, hence, dismissed leaving the appellant to his remedy in the Court as granted by the learned Single Judge in the impugned order.
