MAHESH GROVER, J.

After arguing at length, the appellant states that he confines his grievance in the present proceedings only to the limited extent that the competent authority i.e. Appellate Authority under the Right to Information Act be directed to decide the second appeal which he has preferred, expeditiously. He has also given a statement in writing in this regard which is taken on record.

After hearing the appellant, we dispose of the instant appeal as having been withdrawn but with a direction to the competent authority to consider the grievance of the appellant as expeditiously as possible.

If the appellant makes a request for expeditious disposal, we have absolutely no reason to doubt that the same shall be considered by the competent authority and the concerns of the appellant redressed at the earliest.
