Challenge in the present intra-court appeal is to the order dated 8.11.2012 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition and the order dated 22.7.2014 dismissing the application filed by the appellants for modification of the order. Along with appeal, applications seeking condonation of delay of 803 days in filing and 215 days in refiling have also been filed.

As has been noticed by the learned Single Judge, the writ petition filed by the appellants was dismissed as they had failed to clear the arrears of rent of the property in their possession, which is owned by the Municipal Council, Nabha. The amount was not paid by the applicants-appellants despite even opportunity granted by the learned Single Judge. In support of prayer for seeking condonation of delay of 803 days in filing the appeal, the only ground raised is that applicant-appellant no.1 is an old lady, however, the memo of parties shows that the lady is not the only appellant, rather her sons and one daughter, who are young, are also co-appellants.

Considering the aforesaid facts, we do not find any ground is made out for condoning huge delay of 803 days in filing the appeal. Accordingly, the application for condonation of 803 days delay in filing the appeal is dismissed. Consequently, the appeal and the application for condonation of delay in refiling the appeal are also dismissed.
