SURYA KANT J. (ORAL)

1. This Letters Patent Appeal is directed against an interlocutory order dated 07.09.2016 whereby learned Single Judge has briefly dealt with the contentious issues raised in the writ petition and the *prima facie* merit therein. Consequently, the writ petition has been admitted with a final date of hearing. As regard to the *ad interim* relief, learned Single Judge has observed that the appellant could not make out a *prima facie* case in that regard, hence the same has been declined.

2. We have heard learned counsel for the appellant at a considerable length and are satisfied that the order under appeal, even if the appeal is maintainable, does not warrant interference except to request the learned Single Judge that the writ petition may be preferably heard on

07.11.2016 for final disposal. We thus dispose of this appeal that subject to any part heard case, learned Single Judge may make an endeavour to take up the appellant's writ petition for final hearing on the date fixed.

3. Further, this order shall not preclude the appellant to seek preponement of the date of final hearing.
