MAHESH GROVER, J.

Learned counsel for the appellants contends that the observations of the learned Single Judge mandating the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali to look into the matter and register the FIR against respondent no.3 to 7 (in the writ petition) for the offence committed by them and ensure effective and early investigation amounts to pre-judging the issue and culpability of the appellants.

After hearing learned counsel for the appellants, we are of the opinion that there is merit in what has been urged before us. Therefore, we would only clarify the order of the learned Single Judge dated 20.9.2016 to state that the Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar, Mohali would certainly look into the matter but would register the FIR if need be and after apprising the writ Court. The findings of the enquiry would also be

brought to the notice of the learned Single Judge so as to enable him to pass appropriate orders in this regard.

With the aforesaid clarifications, instant appeal is disposed of.
