MAHESH GROVER, J. _

The appellant is aggrieved of the judgment dated 14.07.2015 rendered by the learned Single Judge.

In writ proceedings the appellant had agitated against the order of the Financial Commissioner who had remanded the matter regarding providing of passage to the Asstt. Collector Ist Grade, Jhajjar.

The grievance of the appellant which he wants to depict from the site plan is that the passage which is sought to be provided dissects his land whereas an alternate route is available, which can be provided by extending the passage already in existence since long. The learned Single Judge noticed that there is no adverse order against the appellant since the matter has been remanded back for decision afresh.

We would have no reason to disagree with the observations of the learned Single Judge, particularly when all the issues are open and available to the parties to raise before the competent authority. Apart from this, the appeal is also barred by an inordinate delay of 167 days which we do not intend to condone in the absence of any plausible explanation.

Dismissed.
