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MAHESH GROVER, J.

This appeal is absolutely frivolous and deserves dismissal. The writ petition is still pending as is also the application filed by the appellant which necessarily has to be dealt with by the learned Single Judge before whom writ proceedings are pending. Learned counsel for the appellant has repeatedly asserted that there has been considerable delay in disposing of the application which in turn has a cascading effect on the project to be executed by it.

After hearing the learned counsel for the appellant, we are of the opinion that these are matters to be raised before the learned Single judge and we have absolutely no reason to doubt that if such issues are raised the learned Single Judge would not seize the urgency of the matter.

No ground for interference has been made out particularly when the appeal is also barred by an inordinate delay of 134 days.

Dismissed.
