SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The appellants are said to have been admitted in the respondent No.3 – Nursing College. Despite the fact that the College was mandatorily required to upload the admission forms before the cut-off date for the academic session 2015-16 to prevent mal-practices in admissions, respondent No.3-College did not upload the appellants' admission forms. The Punjab Nurses Registration Council thus had no knowledge *re:* admission of the appellants. The college as well as the students, namely, the appellants became active only after 31.10.2016 when the examinations were declared to be held w.e.f. 08.11.2016. The hard copies of admission forms are said to have been submitted along with late fee etc. It is in this backdrop that learned Single Judge has declined to grant provisional permission to the appellants for appearing in the Examination.

(2) No case to interfere with the order passed by learned Single Judge is made out.

(3) Dismissed.
