By filing the present Letter Patent Appeal, the appellant has challenged the order of learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition filed by him.

The appellant sought to impugn the punishment of stoppage of five increments with cumulative effect in the writ petition on the ground of discrimination qua other employees, who were allegedly similarly placed.

The issue was considered by the learned Single Judge and finding no merit therein, the writ petition was dismissed. With the change of counsel, the review was filed, which was also dismissed.

Learned counsel for the appellant sought to argue that other issues were also raised in the writ petition. Those may be considered. However, we do not find any merit in the submissions made, as at the time of hearing of the writ petition, the appellant pressed only one issue, which was considered by the learned Single Judge. Even review was also dismissed. The same having gone against the appellant, he cannot now be permitted to raise other issues.

For the reasons mentioned above, we do not find any merit in the present appeal. The same is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the application for delay is also dismissed.
