This order shall dispose of four appeals bearing **Letters Patent Appeal Nos.2457 to 2460 of 2016** as learned counsel for the appellant(s) states that the issue involved therein is identical. For brevity, the facts are being extracted from Letters Patent Appeal No.2457 of 2016

2. The present appeal has been filed under Clause X of the Letters Patent against the judgment passed by learned Single Judge in **Civil Writ Petition No.2125 of 2015** on 11.07.2016 whereby the claim of the appellant-petitioner for appointment in Government service in lieu of acquisition of her land measuring less than 4 kanals, had turned down such claim on the basis of the revised Government policy whereunder it was resolved that no public employment is to be offered to one family member of the landowner where the acquired land is less than 4 kanals.

3. Learned counsel for the appellant(s) fairly submitted that against the impugned judgment dated 11.07.2016, the Division Bench of this Court had already dismissed Letters Patent Appeal No.1674 of 2016 on merits on 05.09.2016.

4. In view thereof, the present appeals are also dismissed for the reasons recorded in Letters Patent Appeal No.1674 of 2016 which was dismissed on 05.09.2016.

5. Since, the present appeals have been dismissed on merits, therefore, no further orders are called for in the application for condonation of delay.
