Learned Single Judge vide order under appeal dated 02.09.2015 though did not approve the action of respondent No.2-Institute for granting admission to an ineligible student who came by way of a writ petition for quashing of the order of cancellation of his admission and to allow him to complete the course of Master in Architecture but having regard to the fact that the appellant-University had presumably failed to take action against the fraudulent institute like respondent No.2, that a compensation of Rs.2.0 lacs has been granted to the aggrieved student, out of which Rs.1.0 lac is recoverable from the appellant-University. With this appeal, a series of documents have been appended in order to show that the University has been vigilant to prevent the private-institutes from indulging in malpractice like admission to ineligible students. None of these documents were brought to the notice of the learned Single Judge. No such plea was pleaded or

Faced with this, learned counsel for the appellant seeks to withdraw this appeal with liberty to file an appropriate application before the learned Single Judge.
