The appellant merely made a complaint against respondent no.5, who was petitioner in the writ petition. On the basis of the complaint of the appellant regarding fake certificate, action was taken against respondent No.5. In the writ petition filed by respondent no.5, the appellant cannot be said to be a necessary party.

There is no error in the impugned order passed by learned Single Judge, dismissing the application for being impleaded as party respondent in the writ petition filed by respondent No.5.

The appeal is accordingly dismissed. Consequently, the application for condonation of delay is also dismissed.
