LPA No.56 of 2016 (O&M)

This order shall dispose of LPA Nos.56 and 75 of 2016 as the point in issue involved in these appeals is similar. For brevity, the facts are being extracted from LPA No.56 of 2016.

2. This Letter Patents Appeal is directed against the interim orders dated 24.9.2015 and 31.10.2015 whereby respondent No.1-College has been permitted to admit 60 students in BAMS course. The order further says that the admission of 10 additional students shall be purely provisional and subject to final decision of the writ petition.

3. The Union of India being aggrieved has filed the instant appeal.

4. Since the learned Single Judge has granted conditional *ad interim relief* subject to final outcome of the writ petition and the main case is stated to be listed for hearing on 26.7.2016, we see no reason to entertain this appeal, even if it is maintainable.

5. Suffice it would be to observe that respondents No.2 and 3 in the writ petition must file their reply, if any, before the date fixed with an advance copy to counsel for the writ petitioner.

6. We request the learned Single Judge to take up the case for final disposal subject to hearing of part heard case on the date fixed.

7. Both the appeals stand disposed of.
