SURYA KANT, J. (Oral)

(1) The appellant was recruited as Constable in the Haryana Police on compassionate grounds in the year 2001. He was found to be a habitual absentee and consequently disciplinary action was initiated against him in the year 2007. He was dismissed from service on 04.09.2007 (P4) but on appeal the Appellate Authority took a lenient view and reinstated him in service by imposing lesser punishment of stoppage of two increments with permanent effect. The incorrigible appellant, however, did not mend his ways and again absented from duty, making lame excuse of ailment etc. In the second enquiry again, a dismissal order was passed which was upheld by the Appellate and Revisional Authorities. Learned Single Judge too has dismissed the writ petition filed by the appellant. In these circumstances, we do not find any ground to interfere with the orders under challenge.
