Aggrieved against the order passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition filed by the appellant raising the issue regarding certain questions to be beyond the syllabus of Environmental Science, the appellant is before this court.

The appellant raised an issue that certain questions did not have relations with Environmental Science. After deleting the same, the marks should be awarded to the appellant. The learned Single Judge has examined the issue in detail and found that the questions, on which objection is sought to be raised by the appellant, are general in nature and are part of the syllabus for classes I to V to be taught by the candidates like the appellant, if finally selected. In the case in hand, the appellant appeared in PSTET-1, to be eligible for appointment as teacher. If the knowledge of the appellant is not upto the extent of basic questions, to which objection is sought to be raised, it is difficult to comment on the quality of teaching finally.

While concurring with the reasons recorded by the learned Single Judge, we do not find any merit in the present appeal. Accordingly, the same is dismissed.
