Rajesh Bindal, J.

The writ petition filed by the appellant having been dismissed by the learned Single Judge, primarily on the ground that appellant did not have come to the Court with clean hands, as he had produced incorrect document on record which on comparison with the original record when summoned in Court, was found wrong.

The entire case built by the appellant was on the basis of the entries made in the ACRs for the period from 18.6.1997 to 31.3.1998. The wrong entries wherein were projected before the learned Court below. The consistent opinion expressed by Hon'ble the Supreme Court and even by this Court is that the High Court can decline to exercise extraordinary jurisdiction in favour of a party who is guilty of suppression veri and suggestio falsi or who makes an attempt to mislead the Court. The case in hands falls in that category. Hence, while concurring with the view expressed by the learned Single Judge, we do not find any reason to interfere in the present appeal. The appeal is accordingly dismissed.
