(1) The appellant assails the order dated 14.03.2016 whereby learned Single Judge has dismissed her writ petition seeking a direction for appointment to the post of Punjabi Mistress.

(2) The facts are not in dispute. The appellant was selected and offered appointment on the above-stated post on contractual basis vide appointment letter dated 21.12.2011. She was required to join within 15 days. It is alleged that the appellant was not permitted to join due to enforcement of Code of Conduct because of ensuing elections. After elections were over, the appellant was allegedly not permitted to join the post due to some pending litigation. No details of such litigation are on record. The appellant made no effort either through representation/legal notice or by approaching the Court to seek a direction for her appointment, for more than 3½ years. She filed a representation on 08.05.2015 to allow her to join duties apparently for the reason that meanwhile services of the Teachers appointed on contract basis were regularized by the State Government. Her representation was not accepted by the Department. The aggrieved appellant approached this Court but learned Single Judge has

turned down her writ petition.

(3) As the facts would speak for themselves, the appellant apparently acquiesced her claim and did not agitate before any forum, if she was not permitted to join the duties as claimed at this belated stage.

(4) No case to interfere with the order passed by the learned Single Judge is made out.

(5) Dismissed.
