MAHESH GROVER.J.

The appellant is aggrieved of the orders dated 12.4.2016 and 25.4.2016.

By the first order process of draw of lots was stayed and by the second order prayer for vacation of stay on an application moved by the applicant was declined.

Learned counsel for the appellant states that the entire process has been held up.

We do not find any reason to modify the orders passed by the learned Single Judge as the main writ petition is pending consideration and that the appellant will not suffer any irreparable loss if the process is held up for some time.

Appeal dismissed.

If the appellant makes a prayer for expeditious final disposal before the learned Single Judge, we have no doubts that such a prayer shall be considered by the Court.
