Marginal delay of 3 days in filing the instant appeal is
condoned.

LPA No.824 of 2016

This appeal is directed against the judgment of the
learned Single Judge dated 17.03.2016.

The only grievance raised is qua quantum of
compensation awarded. The learned Single Judge had enhanced
the compensation from Rs.50,000/-, as awarded by the Labour
Court, to Rs.1,25,000/- for a period of two years employment of
the appellant with his employer.

We do not find any infirmity in the findings recorded by the learned Single Judge and considering that the only issue of enhanced compensation has been raised without touching any other finding recorded by the learned Single Judge, we are of the opinion that the learned Single Judge has applied yardstick on principle laid down by several judgments appropriately. The appellant had not only worked for about two years but had raised his demand after a lapse of six years. Therefore, we do not find any reason to impose our perception even if the best case of enhancement is to be considered over and above that of the learned Single Judge as there is no perversity or illegality therein. The instant appeal is dismissed being without merit.
