The appellant, who claims to be a friend of the alleged detenue, who is living with her parents, filed the petition for habeas corpus. The same having been dismissed, the order has been impugned by filing the present intra-court appeal.

Considering the fact that the appellant merely claims himself to be a friend of the detenue, who is major, the petition for habeas corpus has rightly been dismissed by the learned Single Judge, as admittedly the girl is residing with her parents. There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The appeal is, accordingly, dismissed.
