Challenge in the present intra-court appeal is to the order dated 21.3.2016 passed by the learned Single Judge dismissing the writ petition.

In the case in hand, the appellant sought to challenge the selections made way back in the year 1996 by filing the writ petition 17 years thereafter in the year 2013. The petition was dismissed on account of delay and laches. There is no error in the order passed by the learned Single Judge. The stand of the appellant that he could challenge only after he got certain information regarding the selections is merely to be noticed and rejected, as the petition to challenge any selection can be entertained within reasonable time and not as per the whims and fancies of the person, who seeks to challenge the same.

Accordingly, the appeal is dismissed.
