Applicant seeks condonation of delay of 1602 days in filing the appeal.

Notice of the application to the respondents.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana accepts notice and fairly states that let the instant application be allowed in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (1) SCC (Civil) 242.**

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1602 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal's** case (supra), the applicant-appellant

shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 1602 days in filing the appeal.
