CM No.3724-CI of 2016

Applicants seek exemption from filing certified copy of short order as well as main award dated 28.08.2009 passed by learned Addl. District Judge, Jhajjar.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Exemption sought is granted.

CM No.3725-CI of 2016

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 2268 days in filing the appeal.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana

accepts notice and fairly states that let the instant application be allowed in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (1) SCC (Civil) 242.**

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 2268 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal's** case (supra), the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 2268 days in filing the appeal.
