This is an application for condonation of delay of 460 days in re-filing the accompanying appeal.

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, the delay that has occurred in re-filing the appeal is condoned.

CM No. 3795-CI of 2016

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, same is allowed. Accordingly, legal representatives of

deceased Smt Bachni Devi, appellant, who died on 6.1.2013 as depicted in para No.2 of the application, are brought on record, for the purpose of pursuing the present appeal only.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No. 3796-CI of 2016

Application is allowed. Death certificate of Bachni Devi appellant is taken on record.

RFA No. 1057 of 2016

Notice in appeal.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Shivendra Swaroop, AAG Haryana, present in the Court accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision dated 24.02.2016, rendered by this Court in **RFA No.3860 of 2014** titled “Ajmer Singh vs. State of Haryana”, vide which compensation awarded to the land owners was enhanced to ₹ 3610 per square yards. Therefore, it is submitted that the present appeal be also disposed of in the same terms.

Learned State counsel does not dispute the above position.

That being so, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the decision dated 24.2.2016 rendered by this Court in Ajmer Singh's case (supra).
