CM No.3809-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 618 days in re-filing the accompanying appeal. For the reasons set out in the application which is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Consequently, the delay of 618 days that has occurred in re-filing the accompanying appeal is condoned.

CM No.3810-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 2 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

Main Case

For, concededly, the matter in issue is squarely covered by an order/judgment dated 6.10.2015, rendered by this Court in RFA No.6554 of 2013 (Gurpreet Singh and another Vs. Union Territory, Chandigarh), vide which the compensation awarded to the landowners was enhanced. The present appeal is also disposed of in terms thereof.
