CM No.4756-C1 of 2016

Applicants seek leave of the court to file an appeal on behalf of the legal representatives of late Siri Chand S/o Molar, on the basis of particulars given in para 2 of the application.

After hearing learned counsel for the applicants, instant application is allowed for the reasons stated therein, however, subject to all just exceptions.

Leave sought is granted.

CM No.4755-C1 of 2016

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 1622 days in filing the appeal.

Notice of the application for condonation of delay.

On the asking of the court, Sh. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents no.1 and 2.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1622 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others**, 2015 (1) SCC (Civil) 242, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 1622 days.
