Applicants seek condonation of delay of 811 days in filing the appeal and seek early disposal of the appeal in terms of order dated 05.05.2016 passed in **RFA No.8165 of 2014 (Shanti Devi and others Vs. State of Haryana and others)**.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, both the applications are allowed for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 811 days in filing the appeal stands condoned, however, the applicant-appellant shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 811 days, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437.**
