This is an application for condonation of delay of 2104 days in filing the accompanying appeal. All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicant is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 22.09.2015, rendered by this court in RFA No.2870 of 2009 – Gurdev Singh and others vs. Union Territory, Chandigarh, vide which this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the records.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437 and Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LR. v.

Haryana State and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507, delay of 2104 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, for the period of delay the applicant shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

For, the learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in *Gurdev Singh's case (supra)*, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision.
