Learned counsel for the respondents, after going through the record of the case, submit that present appeal is squarely covered by the order dated 28.3.2016 passed in **Usha Rani's case** (supra).

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, application for condonation of delay of 1973 days is allowed for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 1973 days in filing the present appeal is condoned. However, it is made clear that the applicant-appellant shall not be entitled for interest for this delay of 1973 days, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (civil) 437.**
