After hearing learned counsel for the parties and perusing the records, the application is allowed. Consequently, delay of 649 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned. However, in the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *“Imrat Lal and others versus Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437*, the applicant-appellant shall not be entitled to interest for this period; 649 days.

The application stands disposed of.
