Instant application under Section 24 of the Code of Civil Procedure has been filed seeking transfer of petition, under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act (hereinafter referred to as the “Act”) titled “Ajaypaljit Singh vs. Simrat Kaur”, filed by respondent-husband, from Tarn Taran to the Court of competent jurisdiction at Barnala.

Learned counsel for the applicant states that due to estranged relations with the respondent, the applicant is under apprehension that there is threat and danger to her life from the respondent and his family members. Learned counsel, after seeking instructions from the applicant, further states that petition under Section 9 of the Act may be transferred to Moga, and it will be convenient for both the parties to attend the

proceedings there.

Learned counsel for the respondent states that he has no objection if the petition under Section 9 of the Act is transferred to Moga.

In view of consent of both the parties, petition under Section 9 of the Act, pending in the Court of Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tarn Taran is ordered to be withdrawn and transferred to learned District Judge, Moga, who may assign the same to the court of competent jurisdiction there. Learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Tarn Taran shall ensure that entire record of the case is sent to the learned District Judge, Moga. The parties are directed to appear before the learned District Judge, Moga on 19.03.2016.

Disposed of accordingly.
