This is an application for condonation of delay of 718 days in filing the accompanying appeal.

Despite opportunity, no reply has been filed.

All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicant is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgment, dated 24.02.2016, rendered by this court in RFA No.3860 of 2014, Ajmer Singh and others Vs. State of Haryana and others, vide which this court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the records.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437 and Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others, 2015

(2) RCR (Civil) 507, delay of 718 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, for the period of delay the applicant shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

For, the learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in Ajmer Singh's case (*supra*), the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision. However, the appellant shall not be entitled to interest for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e. 718 days.
