Application is allowed as prayed for. Annexure A1 is taken on record.

CM No.8680-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 735 days in filing the appeal. All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicants is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgement dated 22.12.2015, rendered by this Court in **RFA No.1515 of 2014**, titled “Harijan Co-operative Society Ltd. Versus State of Haryana and another”, vide which, this Court had maintained the compensation awarded for the land that abutted the Safidon-Jind road up to the depth of two acres and enhanced the compensation for the land beyond thereto, to ₹ 24,75,000/- per acre.

Notice in the application.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Shivendra Swaroop, AAG Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf the respondents.

The factual position as set out above, is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437* and *Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507*, delay of 735 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, for the period of delay, the applicants shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

RFA No.3168 of 2016

For, the learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in Harijan Co-operative Society's case (Supra), the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision. However, the appellants shall not be entitled to interest for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e.735 days.
