CM No.878-CI of 2016

As per office report, notice could not be issued, as learned counsel for the applicants-appellants did not file process fee.

Since learned counsel for the State is present in the Court, on asking of the Court, he accepts notice on behalf of the respondents.

Learned counsel for the applicants-appellants has supplied a copy of the paper book to learned counsel for the State.

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, application seeking condonation of delay is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 2507 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437**, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of delay

of 2507 days.

CM No.877-CI of 2016

Applicants seek exemption from filing certified copies of Annexures A-1 to A-3 and award dated 08.12.2008.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Exemption sought is granted.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.879-CI of 2016

Applicants seeks permission to place on record true translated copies of sale deeds Annexures A-1 to A-3.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Sale deeds Annexures A-1 to A-3 are permitted to be placed on record.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.881-CI of 2016

Applicants seek leave of the Court to file the appeal on behalf of late Sh. Khushied Mohamed @ Khurshid Mohd. son of Rahim Khan, on the basis of particulars given in para 2 of the application.

After hearing the learned counsel for the applicants, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein, however, subject to all just exceptions. Leave sought is granted.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.880-CI of 2016

Learned counsel for the applicants submits that since the connected appeals have already been allowed by this Court, instant application has been rendered infructuous and may be disposed of, as such.

Ordered accordingly.

RFA No.322 of 2016

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that present appeal is squarely covered by the order dated 09.02.2016 passed by this Court in **RFA No.2645 of 2009 (Kasam and others Vs. State of Haryana and others)**. They jointly pray for disposal of the present appeal, in terms of the order dated 09.02.2016 passed by this Court in **Kasam's** case (supra).
