Applicants seek condonation of delay of 459 days in filing the appeal.

Notice of the application to the counsel opposite.

On the asking of Court, Mr. Arun Beniwal, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State.

Learned counsel for the State fairly states that let the instant application be allowed but the applicants-appellants may not be held entitled for interest for the afore-said period.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed. Delay of 459 days in filing the appeal stands condoned, however, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for the period of 459 days, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437.**

CM stands disposed of, accordingly.

Main case

Learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the present appeal is squarely covered by the judgment dated 30.10.2015 passed by this Court in **RFA No.9821 of 2014 (Baru and others v. State of Haryana)**, placed on record as Annexure P-1 at page 188 of the paper-book. They jointly pray for disposal of the instant appeal, in terms of the order dated 30.10.2015 passed by this Court in **Baru's** case (supra).

Ordered accordingly.

Consequently, the land owners-appellants are held entitled to

receive

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the compensation for their acquired land, in terms of the order dated 30.10.2015 passed by this Court in **Baru's** case (supra).

Disposed of, accordingly.
