CM No.11007-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 654 days in re-filing the appeal.

For the reasons set out in the application, that is duly supported by an affidavit, the same is allowed. Delay of 654 days in re-filing the appeal is condoned.

CM stands disposed of.

CM No.11006-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 1249 days in filing the appeal. All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicants is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgement dated 01.09.2014, rendered by this Court in **RFA No.2250 of 2011**, titled “Risal Singh versus State of Haryana and another”, vide which, in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this Court had enhanced the compensation to ₹ 18,31,500/- per acre for the land that abutted the main road upto the depth of two acres and @ ₹ 15,00,000/- per acre for the remaining land.

Notice in the application.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Shivendra Swaroop, AAG Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf the respondents.

The factual position as set out above, is not disputed by the learned State counsel.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437* and *Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507*, delay of 1249 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, for the period of delay, the applicants shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

RFA No.3997 of 2016

For, the learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in *Risal Singh's case (Supra)*, the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision. However, the appellants shall not be entitled to interest for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e.1249 days.
