Applicants seeks condonation of delay of 589 days in re-filing the appeal.

CM-1042-CI-2016

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 837 days in filing the appeal

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, the present application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 837 days in filing the appeal stands condoned, however, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 837 days, in view of the judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others v. Land**

Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437.

CM stands disposed of, accordingly.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that the present appeal is squarely covered by the order dated 4.2.2016 passed by this Court in **RFA No.266 of 2012 (Joginder Singh Tokash v. State of Haryana and others)**.
