Applicants seek exemption from filing certified/typed copies of annexure/order.

Application is allowed, as prayed for. Exemption sought is granted.

CM No.10893-CI of 2015

Applicants seek condonation of delay of 402 days in filing the appeal.

Notice of this application was issued.

After hearing the learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 402 days in filing the appeal is condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others VS. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2014 (14) SCC 133**, applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for the interest for this period of 402 days in filing the appeal.

Learned counsel for the appellants submits that present appeal is squarely covered by the order dated 10.12.2015 passed by this Court in **RFA No.1255 of 2014 (Mukesh Kumar Vs. State of Haryana and others)**.
