Matter was referred to Mediation and Conciliation Centre of this Court. As per report received from Mediation and Conciliation Centre, on 26.05.2016 a settlement/agreement was entered into between the appellant and respondent. Perusal of para 6 of the settlement/agreement, it is evident that first party-The Tribune shall pay a total amount of Rs. 12 lacs to second party-Naresh Kumar Tewari as full and final settlement.

Pursuant to the settlement dated 26.05.2016, first party-The Tribune has handed over a demand draft of Rs. 12 lacs drawn on State Bank of Patiala to counsel for the second party-Naresh Kumar Tewari. Photocopy of said demand draft is taken on record.

In view of the aforesaid settlement, present appeal stands disposed of. The parties shall remain bound by the terms and conditions of the settlement/agreement dated 26.05.2016.
