CM No.12550-CI of 2016

This is an application for condonation of delay of 1486 days in filing the appeal. All what has been urged by learned counsel for the applicant is that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the judgement dated 03.09.2014, rendered by this Court in **RFA No.2075 of 2012**, titled “Sohan Lal and another versus The State of Haryana and others”, vide which, in the appeals arising out of the same acquisition, this Court had enhanced the compensation awarded to the landowners.

Notice in the application.

On the asking of the Court, Mr.Shivendra Swaroop, AAG Haryana, present in the Court, accepts notice on behalf respondents No.1 and 2 and Mr.Pritam Saini, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.3 and 4.

The factual position as set out above, is not disputed by learned counsel for the respondents.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and perused the record.

In the wake of the decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015(2) RCR (Civil) 437* and *Dhiraj Singh (D) Tr. LRs. v. Haryana State and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 507*, delay of 1486 days in filing the accompanying appeal is condoned. However, for the period of delay, the applicant shall not be entitled to interest on the enhanced compensation.

CM stands disposed of.

RFA No.4487 of 2016

For, the learned counsel for the parties are ad idem that the matter in issue is squarely covered by the decision rendered by this court in Sohan Lal's case (Supra), the present appeal is disposed of in terms of the said decision. However, the appellant shall not be entitled to interest for the period of delay in filing the appeal i.e.1486 days.
