Applicants-appellants seek condonation of delay of 992 days delay in filing the appeal.

Learned counsel for the applicants-appellants submits that the present case is squarely covered by the order dated 16.9.2015 passed by this Court in **RFA No.7108 of 2012 (Rampal and others Vs. Land Acquisition Collector and another)**.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms.Vibha Tiwari, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondent-State and after going through the record of the case, fairly states that the instant case is squarely covered by the order dated 16.9.2015 passed in **Rampal's** case (supra).

After hearing learned counsel for the parties, instant application is allowed, for the reasons stated therein. Delay of 992 days in filing the appeal stands condoned. However, in view of the law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Imrat Lal and others v. Land Acquisition Collector and others, 2015 (2) RCR (Civil) 437**, the applicants-appellants shall not be entitled for interest for this period of 992 days.

CM stands disposed of.

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In view of the above-said undisputed fact situation obtaining in the present case, the present appeal is ordered to be disposed of, in terms of the order dated 16.9.2015 passed by this Court in **Rampal's** case (supra).

Disposed of, accordingly.
